# **GENERAL CATALOGUE**

In this catalogue, tickets within each price band are sorted firstly into company (i.e., pre-grouping and pre-nationalisation), then British Railways regional order (i.e., Northern, Eastern, London Midland, Scottish, Southern and Western regions).

#### **REVISED ORDERING GUIDELINES**

Tickets from this catalogue will be processed on a 'First Come, First Served' automated-basis.

To give you the best chance of securing the tickets you want, use the online facility (using your email address and password), which many of you are now familiar with. Once an order has been submitted online, the system will inform you which tickets are available instantly. You can submit further orders from the same catalogue, which gives you the flexibility of ordering second choice tickets. Orders will be processed within three working days. Payment processes can be via: PayPal; Credit/Debit Cards (WorldPay Pay by Link); bank transfer or cheque.

We will continue to process orders received via email/telephone/post as soon as possible.

All tickets offered in this catalogue are in at least "very good" condition, i.e. not damaged or mounted, unless otherwise stated in the legend (see below).

**LEGEND** 

A: indicates that the ticket is unissued and has originated from an Audit Office

C: indicates that the ticket is creased

**F**: indicates that the ticket is faded

**G**: indicates that the ticket is grubby or soiled

M: indicates that the ticket has been mounted

We are revisiting our modern Western region collection to add another issue which is from CHELTENHAM SPA and has just been acquired. It is a two coupon day return to Birmingham New Street and is valid for two adults travelling together dated 30-03-1981 with a healthy serial of 2251. This is the first modern Edmondson acquired from this popular and busy station. NCR51's were the normal issue here, along with ultimatic backup. Edmondsons were avoided except in our case where a ticket for two with a high demand called for an Edmondson. Unless of course, the Edmondsons were carefully collected at Cheltenham at the end of the day which would mean that there were not many around for collectors to obtain, I would add that our example has beeen clipped three times. I feel that Edmondsons were rarely used here in modern times. Anyone anything to add?

**Now back to post 1970** pre-nat. Edmondsons and we can feature a two coupon LNER Child Privilege from **HEATON** to Birtley, Cullercoats or Newburn issued 03-04-1970 with a serial of 2798 just about to be issued out I suspect. Birtley and Newburn had already long closed by this date. There must have been many railway families living around here, with a demand for child privilege tickets. We will finish off with the left side of a severed half which was issued at **HERTFORD NORTH** on 30-04-1973, the destination was Brookwood, titled 'Service Military etc.' This facility was well used here as the serial is 5788 and of course the cloass is 'Third' which had long been abolished.


