# THEME CATALOGUE

In this catalogue, tickets within each price band are sorted firstly into company (i.e., pre-grouping and pre-nationalisation), then British Railways regional order (i.e., Northern, Eastern, London Midland, Scottish, Southern and Western regions).

## **REVISED ORDERING GUIDELINES**

Tickets from this catalogue will be processed on a 'First Come, First Served' automated-basis.

To give you the best chance of securing the tickets you want, use the online facility (using your email address and password), which many of you are now familiar with. Once an order has been submitted online, the system will inform you which tickets are available instantly. You can submit further orders from the same catalogue, which gives you the flexibility of ordering second choice tickets. Orders will be processed within three working days. Payment processes can be via: PayPal; Credit/Debit Cards (WorldPay Pay by Link); bank transfer or cheque.

We will continue to process orders received via email/telephone/post as soon as possible.

All tickets offered in this catalogue are in at least "very good" condition, i.e. not damaged or mounted, unless otherwise stated in the legend (see below).

**G**: indicates that the ticket is grubby or soiled




Back on the rails again to continue with our modern Edmondsons: Off to MANEA and and the left hand side of a severed half to 'P/boro' in manuscript, dated by rubber stamp 06-12-1972 with a serial of 0138, the type being a Day Excursion third class. I was under the impression that tickets were issued from the signalbox by this time. Next to MISTLEY and a1st. class privilege to Manningtree in manuscript dated 11-01-1972 with a serial of 0013. This stock would have been withdrawn in the not too distant future. To MORPETH (N) - North Office and a single to Glasgow Queen Street issued on 15-07-1970 with a serial of 0419. These would have been withdrawn and replaced by a NCR21. Still with 1970, 03-05 to be exact we visit SELBY and a Furlough single to Leeds City via Hambleton. There is a high serial of 4418. 1970 stays with us 05-04 to be exact and a two coupon child privilege return from ST. NEOTS to Huntingdon North, with 'P' & 'Child' overprints. The serial is 0169 and this issue would have been bought for a collection. The next issue is also from 13-08-1970 and is a 'Service Military etc'. from SUNDERLAND (N) - North Office to Newcastle.with a high serial of 8147. At last a change of year to 01-05-1973 and the outward portion of a 'Service Military etc.' from THORNABY to York with a serial 0702. Now to 1974 and the well known child single from THORNE NORTH to Goole dated 21-05 with a serial of 0928 and purchased for a collection. Back to 1973 now and a two coupon privilege return from WRESSLE to Leeds (City).with a high serial of 1809, again bought for a collection.






